
Responsibilities

- Reach BU students with the Gospel
 - Develop and implement a plan to engage new areas of Bellarmine.
 - Lead students by modeling a life of evangelism.
 - Diversity of the students in BU CGs reflect the diversity of BU.
- Build BU Student Leaders and Staff
 - BU Staff each have a Personal Development Plan (encompasses personal and professional development).
 - BU Staff have clear expectations and vision for the ministry and their individual role on the team.
 - The number of BU CGs increase each year.
 - The SLT understands the vision and their expectations. They feel cared for.
 - Recruit students to intern at SC BU in the future.
- Send BU Grads to be leaders in Sojourn, Int'l Missions Teams, and Domestic Church plants upon graduation.
 - Improve "senior sendoff" training.
 - Increase numbers of BU students participating in A18 (our summer project) each summer.
 - Increase number of students sent on church plant teams when they graduate.
 - Increase number of students who participate in Journeyman (IMB) or other post-undergrad international opportunities.

Character and Competencies

- Fulfill the character and qualifications of a deacon as outlined in Scripture and the Sojourn Constitution.
- Able to contextualize ministry to a smaller catholic, liberal arts college.
- A track record of making disciples who make disciples.
- Self aware, understands gifts and limitation.
- Demonstrates humility and a desire to learn and grow.
- Has a long view for BU students – desires and works towards them to be life long disciples, not simply while they are in college.
- Embodies the six Sojourn Midtown values: Biblically Faithful, Gospel Centered, Transformative Relationships, Diverse Fellowship Creativity & the Arts, and Relentless Mission.

- Maintains a lifestyle that represents the Gospel and is above reproach.
- Adheres to the Sojourn College staff covenant.
- Aims to work between 40-45 hours per week.
- All Sojourn College staff are support raised – the applicant must be willing to raise and maintain their own funds for this role.
- Commit to at least 2 years in this role.
