Responsibilities

- Sunday Gatherings: Oversee all Sunday morning worship elements.
 - Choosing arrangements and songs
 - o Recruiting and building a volunteer team
 - Writing weekly liturgies.
 - Oversee the audio, visual, and lighting for Sunday gatherings
 - Ensure that all mics and lights are working, slides are ready, team is prepared.
 - Equip and empower a team of volunteers that is able to run AVL
 - Lead weekly rehearsals for the gatherings.
 - Oversee the aesthetics and set of the stage.
- Creative Arts: Help our people experience the gospel in digital expressions.
 - Oversee all elements of our livestreamed services.
 - Manage all video equipment.
 - Train and support team running equipment and livestream.
 - Shoot and edit one low level video per month.
 - Ex. Advent devotionals, Pastoral updates, etc.
 - This would be in coordination of the Connection Director.
- General Responsibilities: Non-specific areas of leadership and support
 - Attend weekly staff meetings.
 - Support and partner with other ministry areas in their efforts further our mission.
 - Care for and disciple people within the church.
